

Guidelines for reopening Adult Bible Classes and Orange for Kids and Youth on September 13, 2020

Smithfield Baptist Church will open our doors for on-campus Bible study with Adults and Orange for kids and Youth beginning Sunday, September 13th at 9:45 a.m. The following practices published by the Governor's Office relating to "Religious Services" on pages 33-36 in "Safer at Home: Phase Three" will be followed.

Adults 65 and Older

1. The **New Beginnings Classroom** will be set aside for those **adults 65 and older** with a limit of 18 adults to ensure six feet apart. Family members may be seated together.
2. Advance registration is required to maintain classroom limits and social distancing. Please register at <https://smithfieldbaptist.org/grow-with-us/on-campus-registration-for-adult-and-orange-classes/> or by calling the church office at 757-357-2536.
3. Masks will be worn while in the building.
4. Class-time will run from 9:45 a.m. to 10:45 a.m. Leaving the classroom and going directly to the sanctuary will limit socializing in hallways.
5. Class instruction will be conducted through technology using the classroom laptop connected to the TV monitor. There will be no literature distribution on Sunday morning. If class literature is wanted, you will need to request it when you register online or by phone. NOTE: All class literature orders will be placed outside the church office with your name on it.
