

Information on Using Google Meet

You do not need a Google Account to participate in Meet video meetings. However, if you do not have a Google Account, the meeting organizer or someone from the class must grant you access to the meeting.

Tip: If you are not signed into a Google or Gmail account, you cannot join using your mobile device.

FROM YOUR COMPUTER

- Use any modern web browser—no download required
- You can start a meeting or join a meeting from any modern browser on your desktop or laptop. There is no additional software to install.
- If you do not have a Google Account, access the meeting URL that is emailed to you to join a Google Meet meeting. The URL will be emailed to you after you have registered online.

FROM YOUR PHONE OR TABLET

- Download the Google Meet mobile app.
- Join, host, or share your screen from the Google Meet mobile app. Download from [Google Play](#) or [Apple Store](#).
